ADMISSION NOTICE

The Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MoTA), Government of India, has established Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) across all states to provide quality education to Tribal Students and other eligible sections of the society (as mentioned in the website). For the Academic Session 2026-27, there will be 07 (seven) EMRS operational in Assam under the administrative control of the Assam State Level Eklavya Model Residential Schools Society (ASLEMRSS), a registered society under the aegis of Department of Tribal Affairs (Plain), Government of Assam.

The admission to Class VI and Class VIII of EMRSs will be done on merit through an Entrance Examination for the Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) located at:

1. Kharadhara, Dist. Bajali, Assam
2. Jalah, Dist. Baksa, Assam
3. Jonai, Dist. Dhemaji, Assam
4. Howraghat, Dist. Karbi Anglong, Assam
5. Ardaopur, Dist. Dima Hasao, Assam.
6. Phuloni, Dist. Karbi Anglong, Assam
7. Dalbari, Dist. Baksa, Assam

The Examination Centres for the Entrance Examination shall also be located in the same districts.

1.4 SELECTION PROCEDURE:

- I. a) The Age Limit for admission to Class- VI shall be *minimum age of 10 Years as on 31/03/2026 and maximum age is 13 Years as on 31/03/2026. Child born on 1st April shall also be considered.*
- b) The Age Limit for admission to Class- VIII shall be *minimum age of 12 Years as on 31/03/2026 and maximum age is 14 Years as on 31/03/2026. Child born on 1st April shall also be considered.*
- c) *The maximum age limit can be relaxed by two years in case of Differently-Abled Children.*
- II. The Family Annual Income of the *applicant shall not be more than 5 lakhs.*
- III. The candidates must be *Permanent Resident of Assam.*
- IV. *Candidate should have qualified Class V for Class VI admission and qualified Class VII for Class VIII admission from a Govt./ Provincialised/ Govt. aided/ Govt. recognized School/ CBSE Affiliated School/ Level B of NIOS OBE Program Or a Candidate who has not attended any school but studied at home is also eligible to apply for admission in Class VI (As per section 4 of Chapter II of RTE Act, 2009). However, the parents/ guardian of the candidate shall have to submit a self- declaration regarding the same.*
